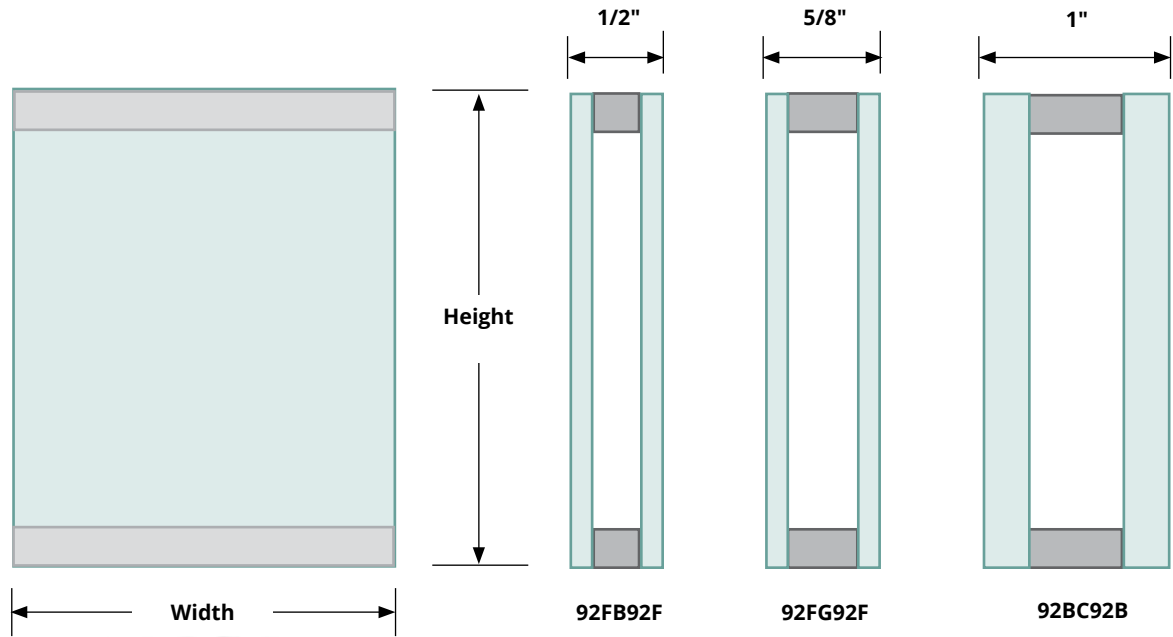


GLAZING - INSU - Insulated Safety Glazing
