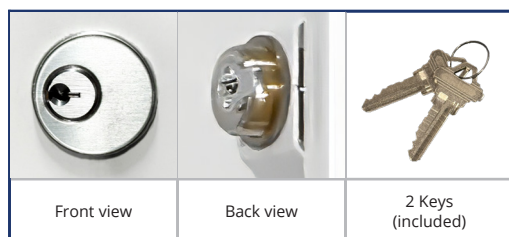

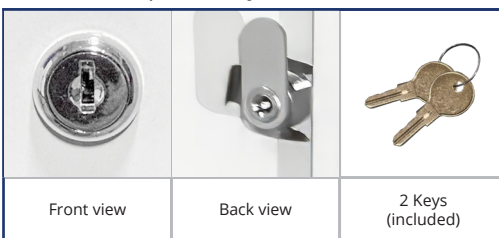

Can Fire Extinguisher Cabinets be Locked?

Yes, per the exceptions listed in International Building Code 2024 IBC Section 906.8 Cabinets used to house portable fire extinguishers shall not be locked. Except where they are subject to malicious use or damage and are provided with a means of ready access and also in Group I-3 and mental health areas in Group I-2 occupancies provided that the staff has keys.
